



## 2013 SALARY INFORMATION

Dear Parents:

Below you will find the most up-to-date information on Nanny Salaries within the New York City metro area. Please keep in mind that each family has different childcare needs. Therefore, salaries can vary greatly based on these requirements.

When determining a Nanny's compensation package, parents should not only take into consideration the weekly hours worked and job responsibilities, but they must also look at each applicant's credentials (education, experience, and specialty). For instance, Specialty Nannies can be paid up to four times the average rate of a traditional nanny. Some of these specialties include: foreign language (most popular—French, Spanish, Mandarin), nursing or teaching credentials, culinary expertise, personal assistant experience, coast-to-coast/overseas travel companion, special training, recreational expert, 10+ years of experience, etc.). Before making an official offer to an applicant, it is always good to consider the whole picture.
